INDIA AT HER BEST

Highest toll tax collection in a day

Nagpur-based Shaktikumar M. Sancheti Ltd (SMSL), entrusted with the 'short term improvements and routine maintenance' of Panipat – Jalandhar section of NH-1 (Km 96- Km 372) by NHAI, collected Rs 42,46,210 as toll tax in a single day from three toll plazas at Karnal, Shambu and Doraha on Nov. 29, 2002. From June 1, 2002-April 31, 2003, the agency had removed 2,068 dead animals from the road. The highest number for a single day was 16 carcasses on July 6, 2002 and for a month, 278 in Dec. 2002. They removed 355 broken down vehicles, the highest per day being seven on Jan. 19, 2003 and per month, 57 in Dec. 2002 and Jan. 2003. Temporary traffic diversions lasting for 15 minutes to 15 hours were made at 544 locations during the same period. Maximum per day was nine on June 30, 2002 and per month, 77 in Jan. 2003.

Banas Sands TTC-JV, a sister concern of SMSL, launched a massive toll collection operation simultaneously at 95 toll plazas comprising 102 toll booths in Delhi on March 21, 2003.
